Description: An Order of the Arrow Troop Representative is a youth liaison serving between the local OA lodge or chapter and his troop. In his troop, he serves as a communication and programmatic link to the Arrowman and adult leaders and Scouts who are not presently members of the Order. He does this in a fashion that strengthens the mission of the lodge and purpose of the Order. By setting a good example, he enhances the image of the Order as a service arm to his troop. By accepting the position of Order of the Arrow Troop Representative, you agree to provide service and leadership to your troop.

- Encourages year round and resident camping in the Troop.
- Enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly.
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law, as well as the OA Obligation.
- Serves as a communication link between the Lodge or Chapter and the Troop.

Expectations

- Complete position-specific Junior Leader Training.
- Attend all (or nearly all) Troop functions.
- Be on time.
- Notify the ASPL in advance and appoint a replacement if you cannot attend an event.
- Set a good example by wearing your uniform correctly (complete uniform, shirttail tucked in, all required badges in their correct locations).
- Set a good example by living the Scout Oath and Law and exhibiting Scout Spirit in your everyday life.
- Train and transition responsibilities to successor.

- Exhibit good self-discipline.
- Have a good attendance record.
- Maintain a positive and enthusiastic attitude.
